The West is struggling with a severe leadership crisis. To elaborate this statement, we need to review the elections that were or will be held in 2024 in various European countries and the US. Similarly, in terms of value-driven ideology, possessing charisma to influencing their competitors and unifying America's allies, Donald Trump and Kamala Harris are completely different from those of the presidents of the United States who led the country a few decades ago. Today, America is facing mental, inexperienced and worn out, which has put the political credibility of US at higher risk. That's to say, Biden is a symbol of a paralyzed America, Trump is a symbol of an insane America, and Kamala Harris is a symbol of a weak character with a strange background.

However, the great Western governments, including the US, have institutions and structures that can reduce the negative impact of their unpopular leaders to some extent. While since those institutions are controlled by the same weak figures, chances are they will also become weak and corrupt.
