

Abductions and Forced Disappearance: A Symbol of a Failed Ideology

Kenya is witnessing an unprecedented wave of abductions and killings targeting various individuals. The Kenya National Commission on Human Rights (KNCHR) expresses deep concern over the alarming rise in abductions, enforced disappearances, and extrajudicial killings across the country. This disturbing trend. Some groups of young protesters marched in downtown Nairobi on Monday, 30th December, while small groups of others staged sit-ins as clouds of tear gas hung in the air.
