According to the news published by Al-Jazeera on 19th December, 2015, the UN Security Council unanimously agreed on a draft resolution for peace talks in January and a ceasefire aimed at ending the war in Syria. According to the statement of US Secretary of State John Kerry, the aim of the resolution is to install a transitional government within first six months and paving the way to election within next 18 months.
