Message of the Eminent Scholar Sheikh Ata Bin Khalil Abu Al-Rashtah To his Facebook Page Visitors on the Occasion of the Coming of the Blessed Eid Al-Adhaa for the Year 1437 AH corresponding to 2016 CE
