Is Suella's Contempt for Islam a Hate Incident?

In a self-righteous article in The Times, British Home Secretary Suella Braverman clumsily exposes her hypocritical stance towards Islam and Muslims in Britain. Similar to how her extremist mentor Michael Gove totally disregarded the children or indeed the facts with his fabricated Trojan horse plot, Braverman is exploiting the children of Wakefield for her narrow and nefarious aims.

She declares the Muslim community bigoted for holding the view that we are uniquely incapable of controlling ourselves if we feel provoked! Such a slanderous and false statement can only come from the mouths of those who make deals with the butcher of Gujarat; who want Muslims to remain silent about the Hindutva mob incitement leading to the murder of Muslims in India, which has now made its way to Britain. They want Muslims to remain silent in the face of increased right wing attacks, as they themselves intend to brush them under the carpet.
