Sixty Years of Agony and Anarchy

Kenya marked 60 years of 'independence' on Tuesday, 12th December 2023. The day is observed annually on December 12, marking the day in 1963 when Kenya gained its so-called independence from British colonial rule.

We in Hizb ut Tahrir in Kenya wish to highlight the following:

The term "independence," after World War II, came to signify "liberation" from colonialism. In reality, this is its superficial meaning only. The truth is that the owner of this matter is the US, which invented it to create an opportunity to strip the colonies from other colonizers. The reality of political leadership in the country since pseudo independence of Kenya from the British, has been the true beneficiary of the hand over as they are the landlords of chunks of lands leaving the general population as squatters.
