**O Youth of the Best Nation Raised for People
Your Place is not in Film Festivals**

The activities of the Khartoum Arab Film Festival, in its second round, was opened in the Sudanese capital, Khartoum, on Friday lasting for five days, through which about 34 films will be shown. The Minister of State at the Sudanese Ministry of Culture, Syed Harun, said that the aim of the festival is to move the recession that hit the film industry; which was developed, adding that the state is interested in developing the film industry, through gathering all those young people who work in the film sector, with the aim of promoting the film industry in Sudan.
