In Light of the Currency Collapse, What do the People of Yemen Wait for from Heads of Government Seeking Help from the West to Support them?

(Translated)

The riyal is still falling against the dollar and other currencies, which has resulted in an increase in the suffering of the people of Yemen, especially in areas under the control of Hadi's meager government. In the same context, Al-Sharq satellite channel conducted an interview with the Prime Minister of Aden Government Maeen Abdulmalik on 15/07/2021, in which questions were asked about the accelerating collapse of the value of the local currency, the riyal, against hard currencies and gold, as the dollar exchange rate exceeded one thousand riyals.

Maeen disclosed in his interview with Al-Sharq TV that Riyadh is using the economic pressure card on his government to make its conference a success, which has been in place for two years without achieving significant progress, and about the tampering of networks of economic interests in Aden - by manipulating the exchange rate of the dollar against the riyal, between them and the central bank in Aden - in obstructing the government's reforms, and playing a negative role in the deterioration of the riyal exchange rate, to preserve their interests. However, he did not disclose the huge quantities that Aden printed during the past few years, and concealed the huge new printing of the riyal without a gold cover that was done by the government of Abd Rabbo.

It is also noteworthy that Maeen Abdulmalik openly announced his recourse to the outside in his statements to Al-Sharq channel yesterday, through his contact with the Secretary-General of the United Nations, Antonio Guterres, in order to obtain the aid of Western countries that they promised to provide at the donors' conference that was held at the beginning of the year 2021 (and the country is full of bounties, while the people of Yemen are almost dead from hunger and war!)

Maeen Abdulmalik announces to the world that his government has relied on external economic support to stabilize the value of the riyal and stop its deterioration, and requests its support in maintaining his government, and preventing it from falling due to its failures in managing the affairs of economic life in particular. At a time when the government of Maeen Abdulmalik is facing economic difficulties and failures, and is seeking help from everywhere, the Houthis in Sana'a obtain a loan of 150 million dollars and receive the support of Western foreign organizations in the aspect of food, health, and the like, as chosen by the provider organizations under the banner of humanitarian relief support.

The governments of Aden and Sana'a are not ashamed of the poor care they provide to the people in Yemen! They are completely dependent on what the Western colonial countries offer them, and they compete intensely over who will win the support of the Western colonial states in obtaining aid. They both deliver Yemen hostage to their political and economic domination over it, and they do not care about the great economic adversities that people face that threaten them with increased need and starvation that loom in Yemen and perish young and old.

The application of the systems of Islam in the political, economic and other realms of life through the establishment of the second Khilafah Rashidah (rightly guided Caliphate) State - which Hizb ut Tahrir works and calls on the people of Yemen to work with it to establish it - is enough to remove all the problems and concerns that the people of Iman and wisdom experience, and to straighten their lives after the need, humiliation and disgrace they suffer from in the absence of the rule of Islam for a hundred years ago. The Messenger of Allah (saw) said: «ثُمَّ تَكُونُ خِلَافَةٌ عَلَىٰ مِنْهَاجِ النَّبِيِّ» "Then there will be Khilafah according to the method of Prophethood."
